

Public Notice of Blasting for Brighton Mountain Wind Farm

Brighton Mountain Wind Farm is a renewable energy project that will help make the provincial grid cleaner and greener.

Phase 1 of the project is currently underway and involves the construction of 34 wind turbines. This work is expected to be completed in 2027.

As we move forward with construction, some blasting will be needed to prepare the ground for building the wind turbines. We recognize these activities will result in an increase in sound levels coming from the construction site and we sincerely apologize in advance for any inconvenience it may cause. Blasting will **begin on Dec. 4 and continue intermittently until Dec. 20**, resuming in January, 2026. Efforts will be made to reduce the impact on local residents and businesses.
