10	<p>Recognition of SMNB's</p> <p>-2026 Corporate Partnerships- Kyle presented the Corporate Sponsorships</p> <p>Curtis Bennett asked Kyle when the numbers from the Trail counters would be available and Kyle answered they would be available in the coming weeks.</p> <p>Kyle also spoke about the Groomer Demo. It will be held the last Saturday of January at Mount Carleton Provincial Park.
